

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, J. S. Risley, of

Clackamas County, and State of Oregon, being above the age of Twenty One years, and being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and declare this to be my last will and testament, in form, as follows, that is to say:

First

I direct that so soon as practicable after my death, all of my just debts and liabilities be first paid:

Second

I give, devise and bequeath to my executor, or trustee, hereinafter named, all of the property of which I shall be the owner, at the time of my death, to be hwd. by him for the following and hereinafter named purposes:

Third

I give and grant unto my executor, or trustee, hereinafter named full power and authority to sell, at public, or private sale, all of my property, both real and personal, upon such terms and conditions, and in such parcels, and in such manner, as to him shall seem best, and for any purpose whatever, whether for the payment of debts, or otherwise; and, I exonerate any purchaser, from the necessity of seeing to the due application of such property; and in making such sale, the said executor or trustee shall not be obliged to obtain authority from any Court, or the consent thereof, or the confirmation of any Court therefor, or thereof, either before or after such sale; and the said executor or trustee shall have full power, until the sale of said property, to lease the same, or any portion remaining unsold, upon such terms as a whole, or by parcels, as to him shall seem best, without order of Court:

Fourth

The proceeds of the sale of the said property shall be disposed of by the said trustee as follows, to-wit:

First. He shall pay all my just debts or liabilities, including expenses of carrying this will into effect, and any expenses connected with the improvement or repairs of the said property and

Second. The balance is to be paid in equal shares to my three children, John F. Risley, Charles W. Risley and Alice M. Risley, or in case of the death of one or more of said children, without issue, the share that such deceased child, or children would take, shall go to my surviving child, or children, but in case such deceased shall leave issue, then such issue shall take the share of the deceased, by right of representation:

Fifth

I hereby direct that the hereinafter named executor, or trustee receive for all of his services, to be performed, no more than Fifty Dollars, and that he shall not keep at any one time more than \$1000. in his hands, without distribution:

Sixth

I hereby nominate and designate my son John F. Risley to be the executor of this my will, and trustee as above referred to, and hereby direct that no bonds or undertaking as such be required of him, but in case the said John F. Risley, for any reason shall fail to qualify as such executor, or trustee, then, in that case, I direct that my other son, Charles W. Risley act as such trustee or executor, with all of the powers and obligations, and upon the same terms that the said John F. Risley would have acted, had he qualified; or in case that said John F. Risley should qualify and enter upon his trust, as said executor or trustee, and should thereafter, and before the said trust was fully executed, from any cause, cease to be executor or trustee, as aforesaid, then in that case, I direct that said Charles W. Risley shall qualify in like manner and have the same power that the said John F. Risley would have had, had he continued to execute the trust until it was completed, and in either case, the said Charles W. Risley shall not be required to give a bond or undertaking as such executor, or trustee. And in case neither of my said sons should qualify as executor, or trustee, or having qualified should fail to completely execute the said trust, then the Court may appoint some one to execute or complete the execution of, as the case may be, the said trust.
